The Contractor was asked to provide a lid for the sedimentation tank or to cover the tank properly. During the subsequent inspection on 26th October 2006, the exposed tank was seen to have been covered by tarpaulin. The Contractor has also cleared up the stagnant water which was previously found in the trench along Slip Road A near the site office in N1 Division. During the inspection on 26th October 2006, stagnant water was observed to have been accumulated inside the drip tray in the workshop near site office and inside the gullies along Slip Road E in N2 Division. The Contractor was reminded to clear up the stagnant water promptly to prevent mosquito breeding.
