- During the inspection on 2nd April 2007, sandbags barrier bounding M3 and M4 works areas was observed to have been broken. Site runoff was observed to have seeped through sandbags to Kwu Tung Road. The broken sandbags were seen to have been replaced and the water was seen to have been cleared up immediately.

- During the inspection on 10th April 2007, water outflow from the sedimentation tank in the N1 Division beside San Tin Highway appeared to be silty. Water outflow from the sedimentation tank was stopped immediately after the inspection. The Contractor was reminded to use sedimentation tank with sufficient capacity to increase the retention time of sedimentation process, especially when it is after rainstorm event.
- During the inspection on 10th and 12th April 2007, stagnant water pool was observed to have been accumulated in an unused sedimentation tank beside Box Culvert BC2 in N1 open lay-down area. Stagnant water pool was seen to have been cleared up and the unused sedimentation tank was seen have been placed up-side-down during the inspection on 14th April 2007 to prevent water from accumulation.
- During the inspection on 12th April 2007, C&D waste (wooden debris) and rubbish (plastic bottles) were observed to have been accumulated outside pier F3 retaining wall at the edge of EMDC in N2 Division, which could accidentally fall into EMDC. The wastes were seen to have been cleared up during the inspection on 14th April 2007. The Contractor was reminded that C&D waste should be collected properly and stored in designated storage area prior to disposal.
- No specific water quality issue was observed during the inspection conducted on 14th April 2007.

- During the inspection on 26th April 2007, stagnant water pools were observed to have been accumulated inside gullies along Slip Road A and F works areas; in sedimentation tank at South Abutment in the N1 Division; inside the workshop near the site office; inside U-channel and drip tray in the Slip B works area in South Division; inside U-channel and manhole cover in the M1 works area in the South Division. Stagnant water pools were seen to have been cleared up during the inspection on 28th April 2007.
- During the inspections on 26th and 28th April 2007, C&D waste (wooden debris) was observed to have been accumulated at pier F3 retaining wall near the edge of EMDC in N2 Division. C&D waste should be collected promptly and stored in designated storage area prior to disposal. C&D waste should not be placed near the edge of EMDC to prevent accidental fall into EMDC.
