During the inspection on 5th May 2007, the stagnant water pool beside pier F3 retaining wall works area was still observed, and litter was seen to have been collected and disposed of properly. The Contractor was reminded to clean up the stagnant water pool promptly to avoid mosquito breeding. Rubbish collection bins should be provided for the pedestrians to avoid littering into the temporary trench.
