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## 1. Background

- 1.1 Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD) is the Project Proponent and the Permit Holder of Agreement No. CE 45/2008 (CE) Liantang / Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point and Associated Works (hereinafter referred as "the Project"), which is a Designated Project to be implemented under the latest version of Environmental Permit number EP-404/2011/D which was granted on 20 January 2017.
- 1.2 To facilitate the project management and implementation, the Project was divided by six CEDD work contracts and an Architectural Services Department (ArchSD) Contract as follows:
- CEDD contract no. CV/2012/08 (Contract 2) •
- CEDD contract no. CV/2012/09 (Contract 3)
- CEDD contract no. NE/2014/02 (Contract 4)
- CEDD contract no. CV/2013/08 (Contract 6)
- CEDD contract no. NE/2014/03 (Contract 7)
- CEDD contract no. CV/2013/03 (Contract 5) (The construction works of Contract 5 was substantially completed on 31 August 2016 and the relevant duties under EM&A were handover to Contract 6)
- ArchSD contract no. SS C505 (this Contract is managed by ArchSD and the Architect)
- 1.3 The Heung Yuen Wai Highway and connecting roads under the Project was opened on 26 May 2019. Following the partial commencement of the Project, the major construction works for Contract 2, Contract 3, Contract 4, Contract 6, Contract 7 and Contract SS C505 have been substantially completed and majority of works areas have handed over to relevant responsible parties / Departments for operation.

## 2. Substantial Completion of Construction Works of CEDD's Contracts

2.1 The construction activities under Contract 5 have been completed in September 2016 and area under Contract 5 were handover to SS C505 and Contract 6 after completion. Subsequently, substantial completion for the Works for Contracts 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 and SS C505 has been achieved in 2019. Apart from Contract 6, construction phase Environmental Monitoring and Audit (EM&A) in relation to Contract 2, Contract 3, Contract 4, Contract 7 and Contract SS C505 were terminated after approval by Environmental Protection Department (EPD). The termination status is summarized in below table.

## 3. Substantial completion for the Remaining Works of Contract 6

3.1 Contract 6 is the last remaining section of works under LT/HYW BCP Project that the Construction Phase EM&A Programme still prevails. Substantial completion for remaining works of Contract 6 has been achieved and the certification of completion of the Work, which cover the whole project including Section VIIA, Section IXA, Section III, Section II, Section IE, Section IV, Section V, Section XI, Section IC, Section IA, Section IB, Section ID, Section VI were shown in *Annex A1* and the associated Section of Works is shown in *Annex A2*. The Proposal for Termination of Construction Phase EM&A Programme for Remaining Contract 6 was submitted by AECOM on 15 July 2021 (AECOM's ref.: (CV/2013/08)/M45/200/(H12466)).

## Site inspection with EPD on 12 August 2021

3.2 Following the termination proposal of Contract 6 in 2021, joint site inspection with the representative of EPD, the Independent Environmental Checker (IEC), the Environmental Team (ET), CEDD, Engineer's Representative (ER) – AECOM and Contractor of C6 (CCKJV) was conducted on 12 August 2021. After the site inspection, EPD provided comments on their concerns about the potential environmental impact due to the remaining works near the site office of Contract 6, Sha Tau Kok Interchange and near Ping Yeung Interchange, in particular the potential water quality impact (i.e. site run-off) to the nearby streams in the forthcoming wet seasons.

## Additional work under Contract 6

3.3 In December 2021, there was additional work instructed to Contract 6 and the works involved construction of flood wall and maintenance ramp for Kong Yiu Channel. An Environmental Review Report (ERR) to assess the environmental impacts associated with the additional work was conducted by AECOM and the ERR was agreed by EPD via email in late December 2021. The ERR concluded that no environmental impacts are anticipated with the implementation of good site



practices and mitigation measures. Existing environmental monitoring for water quality (WM1-C and WM-1) and weekly site audit are recommended to be continued to cover the construction phase of the proposed Project work. Location of additional works was illustrated in Annex A3.

3.4 In view of the additional work and consideration potential environmental impact for the remaining works, the Proposal for Termination of Construction Phase EM&A Programme for Remaining Contract 6 was withdrawn by AECOM on 25 October 2021.

## Completion of remaining works and additional work of Contract 6

- 3.5 Following the EPD's comments on the 12 August 2021, as clarified by CCKJV and confirmed by AECOM, the site office of Contract 6 near Wo Keng Shan was dismantled in early November 2022 and the works at near original site office of Contract 6 and Sha Tau Kok Interchange were completed. The bare slopes / banks near original site office of Contract 6 and Ping Yeung Interchange have been impacted and hydroseeded, and potential water quality impact (i.e. site run-off) to the nearby streams in the wet seasons as concerned by EPD have been minimized. Recent photos taken in April 2023 are shown in Annex A4.
- 3.6 Moreover, the major construction activities for the additional works including construction of flood wall and maintenance ramp for Kong Yiu Channel was completed in February 2023. Recent photos taken in April 2023 are shown in Annex A4.
- 3.7 As advised by CCKJV and confirmed by AECOM, the remaining works for Contract 6 include the of flood panels by hand tools in Wetland were completed in late May 2023. Other miscellaneous remaining works under Contract 6 will include railing installation work and concrete walkway repair work were completed in late May 2023 as well.

#### **Remaining work under the Project** 4.

- 4.1 As advised by AECOM, the original Contract 6's site office areas near Wo Keng Shan have been handover to CEDD's Landscape Term Contractor (appointed under Contract No. CV/2020/05) for remaining planting works and establishment works. The Landscape Term Contractor under Contract CV/2020/05 was reminded to follow the environmental requirements including the Environmental Permit, EM&A Manual, EM&A Programme and Implementation Schedule for the environmental mitigation measures, etc. for the Project.
- 4.2 The planting works at Wo Keng Shan Road were conducted from 19th December 2022 to 13th March 2023 and have been completed by the CEDD's Landscape Term Contractor, who was appointed under Contract No. CV/2020/05. Recent photos taken in April 2023 are shown in Annex A4.



4.3 Besides, the remaining works for installation of flood panels by hand tools in Wetland will expect to be completed in late May 2023. Other miscellaneous remaining works under C6 will include railing installation work and concrete walkway repair work, which are expected to be completed in mid- May 2023.

## 5. Review on Environmental Impact for remaining works of Project

- 5.1 In view of completion of construction activities under Contract 6, it is proposed to terminate the Construction Phase EM&A Programme. The termination proposal is prepared with reference to the following guidelines:
  - completion of construction activities and insignificant environmental impacts of the a) remaining outstanding construction works;
  - trends analysis to demonstrate the narrow down of monitoring exceedances due to b) construction activities and the return of ambient environmental conditions in comparison with baseline data; and
  - no substantiated environmental complaint and prosecution. c)

5.2 Review of environmental impacts of the remaining works are presented in below.

## **Construction** Noise

- All heavy construction plants such as excavator, crane etc. have been removed from the Project area. Only hand-held electric equipment would be used for the defect and remaining works under Contract 6. The construction noise impact generated from remaining works of Contract 6 is considered negligible.
- There are no effective Construction Noise Permit for Contract 6 and there will be no scheduled works during restricted hours (i.e. evening time, night time, Sunday, public holidays).
- There were no Limit Level exceedances for noise monitoring recorded at the monitoring stations (NM2a, NM3, NM4, NM5 and NM6) during full scale construction. The noise levels were fluctuated well below the Limit Level and return of ambient environmental conditions in comparison with baseline data.
- There was one occasion of project-related noise complaint and one occasion of project-related nuisance by vibration received for the Contract and they were rectified by the Contractor immediately. Investigation for all the environmental complaints has been conducted according to the EM&A Manual and the details were all reported on the EM&A reports. All the environmental complaint received during construction phase has been settled. No further noise complaint was received after substantial completion for the Works under the Contract.



## Air Quality

- Most of the project areas have been covered with hard-paved roads and planted areas. All • heavy construction plants such as excavator, crane etc. have been removed from the Project area. Only hand-held electric equipment would be used for the defect and remaining works under Contract 6. The construction dust impact generated from remaining works is considered negligible.
- There were no project-related exceedances for air quality monitoring recorded at the related monitoring stations (AM2, AM3, AM4b, AM5a, AM6 and AM7) during full scale construction. Relevant action for exceedance has been taken according to the Event and Action Plan and reported on the EM&A reports. There were no exceedances for air quality monitoring recorded at the nearby monitoring stations after substantial completion and exceedance is not anticipated for the defects works.
- There were four occasions of project-related dust complaint received for the Contract and they were rectified by the Contractor immediately. Investigation for all the environmental complaints has been conducted according to the EM&A Manual and the details were all reported on the EM&A reports. All the environmental complaint received during construction phase has been settled. No further dust complaint was received after substantial completion for the Works under the Contract.

## Water Quality

- Most of the project areas have been built with completed paving. Rain water was collected from • open areas drain to the permanent storm drains. The water quality impact generated from remaining works is considered negligible.
- There were certain cases of project-related water quality exceedance recorded during full scale construction and they were rectified by the Contractor immediately. Relevant action for all exceedance has been taken according to the Event and Action Plan and reported on the EM&A reports. There were two exceedances for water quality monitoring recorded at the nearby monitoring station after substantial completion which concluded as non-project related. Besides, there are no water quality exceedance recorded the past six months and exceedance is not anticipated for the remaining works.
- There were ten occasions of project-related complaint for water quality received for the Contract and they were rectified by the Contractor immediately. Investigation for all the environmental complaints has been conducted according to the EM&A Manual and the details were all reported on the EM&A reports. All the environmental complaint received during construction phase has been settled. No further complaint in relation to water quality was received after substantial completion for the Works under the Contract.



## Waste Management


- Since the generation of C&D waste is minimal, no adverse impact is anticipated for the defects works.
- General refuse generated for remaining works will be disposed to North East New Territories Landfill only and the amount of general refuse is minimal when compared to full scale construction.
- No chemical wastes are envisaged from the remaining planting works as construction phase works are completed. For example, no stockpile of fuel and hydraulic oil, etc. Also, no maintenance of powered mechanical equipment would be carried out on site, hence no collection of spent oil. Besides, no significant quantity of paints and thinners used on site anymore.

## Landscape and Visual

- A five-year monitoring programme for woodland compensation was carried out between September 2016 and August 2021, in accordance with the approved Woodland Compensation Plan. The ecological monitoring report for the woodland compensation area (June 2021 to August 2021) was submitted to EPD as the last monitoring report. The woodland compensation area had handover to AFCD and no follow up measures under the EM&A is required.
- Monitoring of Wetland Compensation Area at establishment stage has been conducted for one year duration in accordance with the approved Habitat Creation and Management Plan. The establishment stage of wetland was commenced in October 2020 and completed in September 2021 for 12 months. The monitoring results of ecology and water quality were generally in order, and no follow up measures under the EM&A is required.
- The implementation of landscape mitigation measures during establishment period had been audited by a qualified landscape architect by mean of site inspection in August 2019 to July 2020. Besides, further to the Landscape Plan (Rev.4) approved by EPD via letter dated 7 June 2021, minor changes on site layout was required, AECOM then submitted the Landscape Plan Rev.5 to EPD on 31 May 2022 and has been approved by EPD on 16 September 2022.

## 6. Proposed termination of Construction phase EM&A programme for the entire Project

6.1 In view of completion of major construction activities under Contract 6 and insignificant environmental impacts for defect work of Contract 6, it is proposed to terminate the Construction Phase EM&A Programme for the entire Project, as summarized in below table. In addition, Monthly/Quarterly EM&A Reporting will be ceased after the proposed termination of Construction Phase EM&A of Contract 6 and entire project is approved.


## 7. EM&A Activities after Termination of Construction phase EM&A programme


7.1 It should be noted that the proposed termination of construction phase EM&A will not affect the operational traffic noise monitoring, which is under the scope of Contract 6 and required under the updated EM&A programme. The EM&A activities that would still be conducted after proposed termination is listed in below:




