



HB3: K4 Air Raid Protection Tunnels
 These tunnels served some workers from former Whampoa Dock back to World War II in 1940s during the invasion of Kowloon by the Japanese in which the dockyard was heavily bombed by Japanese aircraft with large casualties.

GB3: Built in 1873. It is a traditional Chinese temple, which is divided into front hall, middle hall and main hall.
