The building contains a mixture of Chinese and Western Architectural styles (Chinese Renaissance with Italian Florentine elements. The chapel has been described as Chinese Modern Eclectic in style. Architectural features of the building include green glazed Chinese style roof tiles, red columns and grey walls and complex ornamental patterns.
