#### Set Back and Fixed Windows Requirements on the lease condition

- 2. Referring to our teleconversation on 21.3.2014, I was given to understand that the concerned issues are the building set-back and the environmental assessments required by EPD, and the environmental issue concerned is noise. I would advise that EPD should confirm that the requirements for the developers to conduct the noise impact assessments for the concerned sites would not cause insurmountable problem in achieving the developments under the relevant sale conditions. Subject to EPD's confirmation, such requirements could be submitted for DLC's consideration for the proposed land sales/sale conditions under the applicable procedure as and when the relevant sites are available for consideration for disposal.
