RE: Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Ordinance, Cap. 499, Section 6(2) Application for Approval of EIA Report Request for Information under Section 8(1) of the EIA Ordinance Expansion of Hong Kong International Airport into a Three-Runway System (Application No: EIA-223/2014)

- Marine Ecology and Fisheries Enhancement Strategy (MEFES) and the Environmental Enhancement Fund (EEF), which consists of both the Marine Ecology Enhancement Fund (MEEF) and Fisheries Enhancement Fund (FEF);
- Fisheries Enhancement Strategy (FES) and the FEF; and
- Aircraft phasing-out plan and the aircraft noise monitoring plan in the Environmental Monitoring and Audit programme.
