

Exchange with the Bureau of Environmental Protection of Guangzhou Municipality in Hong Kong

On 3rd August 2007, the Bureau of Environmental Protection of Guangzhou Municipality (GZEPB) and the Hong Kong Environmental Protection Department (HKEPD), led by Mr. Ding Hong Du, Director General, and Miss Anissa Wong, Permanent Secretary for Environment/Director of Environmental Protection respectively, shared experience on checking the emissions of in-use vehicles and discussed thoroughly the latest technological developments. At the meeting, we elaborated on our introduction of the advanced lug down smoke test for diesel vehicles and our study on using remote sensing equipment and transient dynamometer emission testing for checking the emissions of in-use petrol and LPG vehicles. GZEPB also explained their plan to adopt advanced vehicle emission testing technologies. Both GZEPB and HKEPD valued the opportunity to share experience with each other and would like to continue such exchange.
