

NOISE CONTROL (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATION 1994

(Made after consultation with the Advisory Council  
on the Environment under section 27(1A) of the  
Noise Control Ordinance (Cap. 400))

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 August 1994.

2. Forms

The Schedule to the Noise Control (General) Regulations (Cap. 400 sub. leg.) is amended -

(a) in Forms 5 and 7, in paragraph 2 -

(i) by repealing "\$50,000" and substituting  
"\$100,000";

(ii) by repealing "\$100,000" and substituting  
"\$200,000";

(iii) by repealing "\$10,000" and substituting  
"\$20,000";

(iv) in the Chinese version -

(A) by repealing "\$50,000" and  
substituting "\$100,000";

(B) by repealing "\$100,000" and  
substituting "\$200,000";

(C) by repealing "\$10,000" and  
substituting "\$20,000";

(b) in Forms 8 and 10, in paragraph 2 -

- (i) by repealing "\$50,000" and substituting "\$100,000";
- (ii) by repealing "\$100,000" and substituting "\$200,000";
- (iii) in the Chinese version -
  - (A) by repealing "\$50,000" and substituting "\$100,000";
  - (B) by repealing "\$100,000" and substituting "\$200,000".

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Regulation is to change the references to the amount of fines under various sections of the Ordinance in the Schedule to the Noise Control (General) Regulations to bring them in line with the increases in the fines provided by the Noise Control (Amendment) Ordinance 1994 (2 of 1994).
