Short Paper on responses to the recommendations of the EIA Sub-committee Advisory Council on the Environment (ACE)

EIA Study for the Route 3 Country Park Section
The Ting Kau Bridge and Approach Viaduct

In the third EIA Sub-committee meeting held on 5.7.1994, Members agreed to recommend the EIA Report for the Ting Kau Bridge and Approach Viaduct to the main Council for endorsement subject to the following conditions:

- (a) further ecological survey between now and the start of the contract be carried out; and
- (b) consideration be given to more planting than indicated.

The following are responses to the recommendations of the EIA Sub-committee:

- (a) effort is being made to arrange further ecological survey before commencement of the works;
- (b) the comprehensive landscaping scheme proposed by the preferred tenderer would include provision of roughly 170 000 number of trees/shrubs and hydrosecding an area of approximately 150 000 square metres with tree and grass seed.
