Noise Impact Assessment

Thank you for your information provided via your previous memos to us in relation to the operation of the firing range at Lo Wu Classification Range.

2. As required by EPD recently, additional on-site noise measurements inside the boundary of the firing range should be conducted for the noise impact assessment of the above Study. As such, we would like to seek your permission for our Consultants, Ove Arup & Partners Hong Kong Ltd. (Arup), to conduct noise measurements inside the firing range with proposed details as follows:

Option 1 (Preferred)

- (a) Date: Half-day session(s) between 16 and 27 of May 2011
- (b) Duration: 3 hours for each half-day session (subject to the no. of types of guns)
- (c) Measurement Locations: 1m from different types of guns used

Option 2

- (a) Date: Half-day session(s) between 16 and 27 of May 2011
- (b) Duration: 3 hours for each half-day session (1 hour for measurement and 2 hours for setting-up and dismantling measurement equipment)
- (c) Measurement Locations: Locations A, B and C as shown in the attached figure (**Annex A**)
- (d) Operation Mode: Peak operation of shooting range area 1 as shown in the figure at Annex A

3. Apart from giving your permission on the above proposed noise measurement, I should be grateful if you would also provide the following supplementary information for both options to facilitate the noise impact assessment:

- (a) Frequency of usage of shooting range areas 1 and 2 including the types of guns (rifle, revolvers, etc) used as shown in the figure at Annex A in Years 2008, 2009 and 2010;
- (b) No. of shoots within 30 minutes for the peak operation mode in shooting range areas 1 and 2; and

- (c) No. of rounds of police officer practising shooting in shooting range areas 1 and 2 within 30 minutes.

4. Grateful if you would also provide the information as requested in our memo in NTNTPF 2/6/43 (T) in Pt. 5 dated 3.3.2011 (copy attached at **Annex B**) in relation to the operation of the firing range at Lo Wu Classification Rang within the period from 14 February 2011 to 25 February 2011.

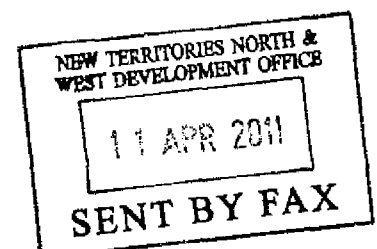

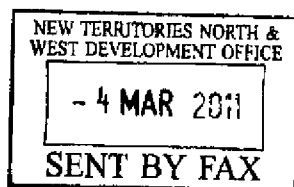
