Description: An armchair style grave set into a hill slope that has been secured by shotcrete. The grave is made of concrete and has a black plaque with obscured lettering. The grave has a round edged enclosure behind the plaque and an oval platform of concrete is located in front of the grave (enclosed by low side walls). There are red circle decorations over the plaque and in the centre of the back enclosure wall. Description of Environmental Setting: The grave is set at the base of a wooded hillside with mostly abandoned buildings to the north. There are also some abandoned graves in the vicinity and a collection of modern urns further up the hill and to the north.
