



1. Introduction

Construction dust (CD1) and noise monitoring (CN3) during the course of construction works are recommended at Queen Elizabeth Hospital (QE) – Specialist Clinic for construction works at Wylie Road construction site according to the approved EIA and EM&A manual. As the access to the Clinic has been denied for demolition and further development, Methodist School has been selected as alternative dust (CD1a) and noise monitoring (CN3a) station in the Alternative Proposal for QE – Specialist Clinic in Aug 2013.

2. Construction Programme

According to the latest programme and site condition, all KTE related construction works at Wylie Road site has been completed substantially in end June 2016 and the tennis court has been reinstated and would be handed over to Club de Recreio.

3. Termination of Monitoring at CD1a and CN3a

By considering the substantial completion of works at Wylie Road construction site for KTE project, MTR would like to terminate the dust and noise monitoring stations at Methodist School starting from end July 2016. The location of CD1a and CN3a and the current condition of site could be referred to the location plan and photos below.

Figure 3.1 Location of CD1a and CN3a at Methodist School for Wylie Road construction site

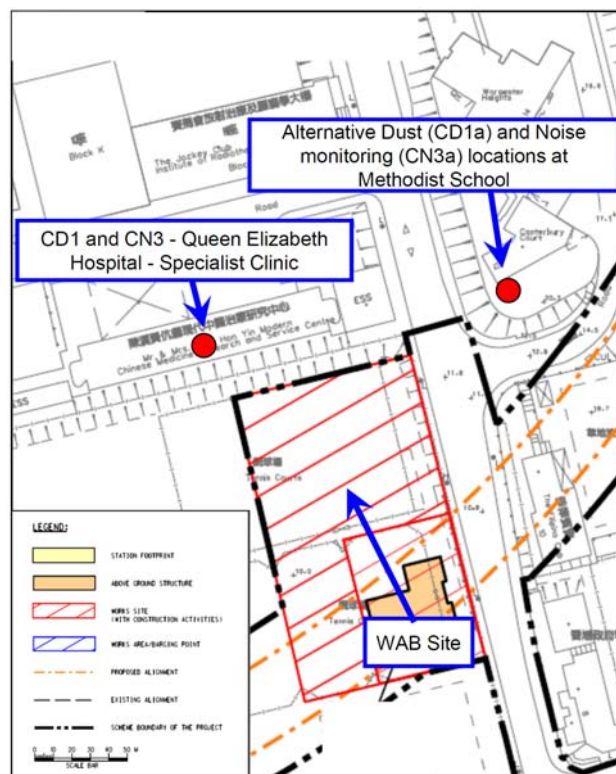


Photo 3.1 Current site condition of MTR Wylie Road ancillary building

The overall trends of the monitored parameters over the course of the construction works at Wylie Road were shown in the Appendix A.

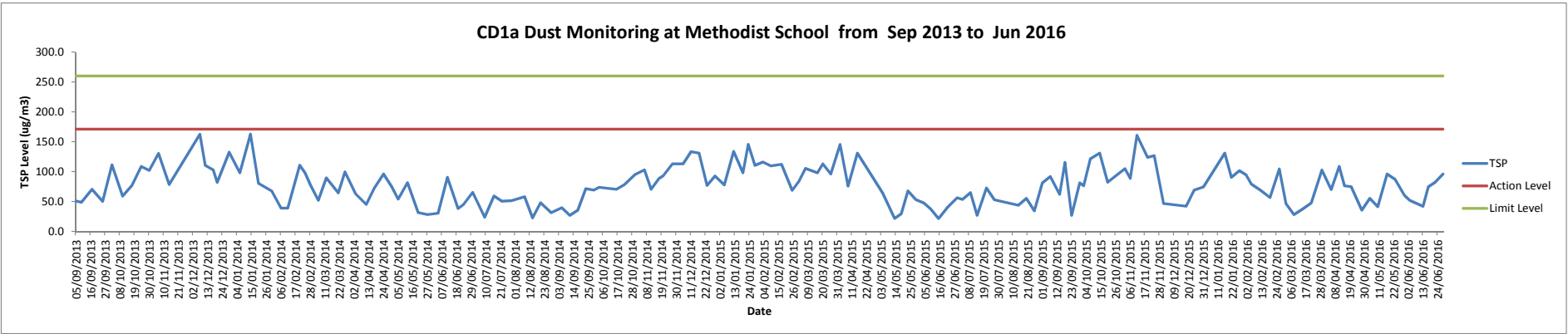
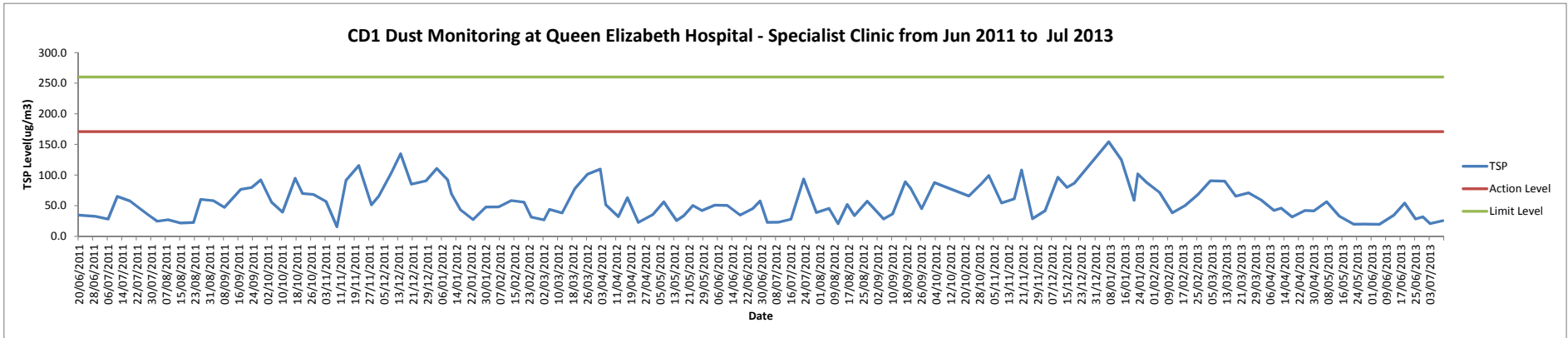
Since the commencement of monitoring at CD1/CN3 at QE and CD1a/CN3a at Methodist School, all the monitoring results complied with the Limit Levels.

Nevertheless, two air nuisance complaints have been referred from EPD regarding cases of suspected emission of exhaust from construction plants. Relevant actions have been taken according to the Event and Action Plan and reported in EM&A report in November 2014 and April 2015 respectively. Both complaints are invalid complaint to the project and have been settled.

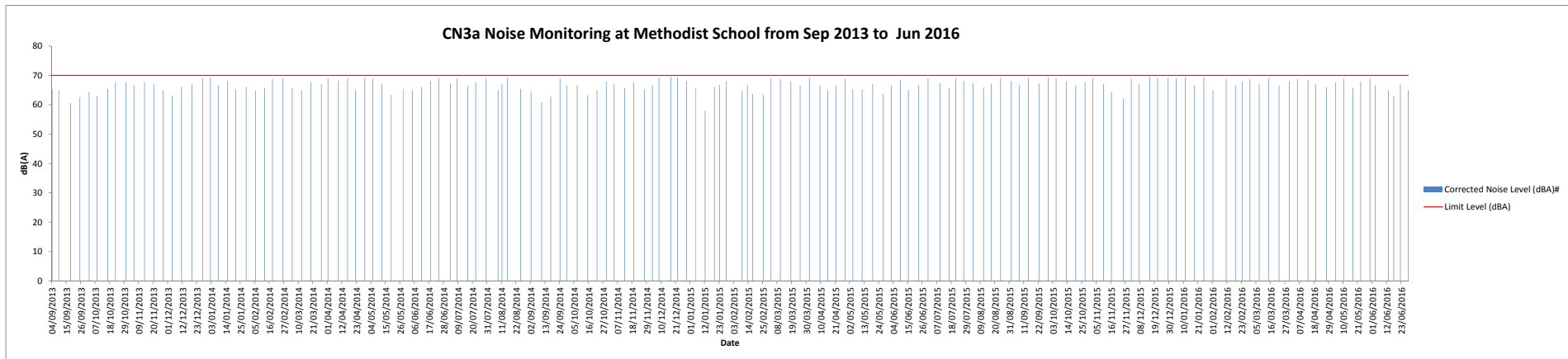
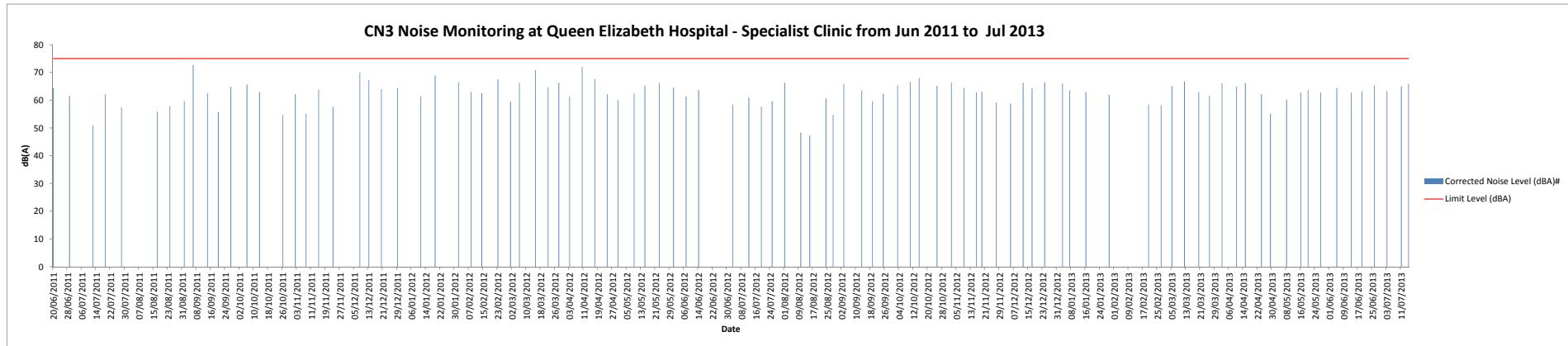
No record of noise complaint or summons / prosecutions received in the vicinity of Wylie Road site.
