



View 4: Summit of Lantau Peak

This is a more typical hazy day with Tung Chung and the airport barely visible in the distance. In these conditions the cable car will only intrude on hillwalkers' views from locations closer to the alignment, e.g. Nei Lak Shan (refer photomontage)


View 5: Sha Lo Wan Pier.

Tower 3 will be visible on the distant ridgeline from this vantage point. However, from the villages and coastal path (west of San Tau) the cable car is generally concealed from view by the intervening topography and vegetation

View 6: Airport Terminal

The airport is a relatively long distance from the cable car and even on a sunny day as shown here the smog layer obscures both town and mountain

Note: Broken line in view indicates approximate visible alignment of cable car
