I refer to your above quoted memo regarding the captioned subject. Please note that you are required to explore in details all feasible ex-situ treatment, disposal and beneficial reuse options of sediment management to avoid/minimise the disposal of the 1.4 Mm³ Category L and 4.1 Mm³ Category M/H sediments arising from your works. If disposal of sediment is unavoidable after you have exhausted all management options, the possible sites for the Category L and Category M/H sediments are -

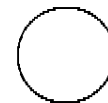
Category of Sediment	Appropriate Disposal Sites
Category L Sediment	Open Sea Disposal at South Cheung Chau Open Sea Sediment Disposal Area
	Open Sea Disposal at East Ninepin Open Sea Sediment Disposal Area (ENP-ODA). The ENP-ODA only operates from 16 March to 30 September of a year inclusive.
Category M _p Sediment	Project proponents should follow the arrangement of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge project for cross-boundary disposal of M _p sediment generated from their projects as one of the feasible options for disposal of M _p sediment.
Category M _f Sediment	Confined Marine Disposal at East Sha Chau Confined Marine Disposal facility and South of Brothers Confined Marine Disposal facility. If the South of Brothers Confined Marine Disposal facility is not available as scheduled (July 2012), there will not be sufficient capacity at East Sha Chau Confined Marine Disposal facility to meet the demand.
