**Shatin to Central Link – Hung Hom to Admiralty Section
Land Contamination Assessment**

AECOM Asia Co. Ltd. has been appointed as environmental consultant by MTRC to undertake land contamination assessment for the captioned project. We have noted that there are two aboveground storage tanks for boilers located in Wan Chai Swimming Pool near the intersection of Tonnochy Road and Harbour Road during our site appraisal.

We are seeking your approval to allow us performing borehole drilling and soil sampling beneath the aboveground storage tanks. The sampling location is shown in the enclosed figure. A borehole of maximum ~30m below ground surface would be drilled so that we can collect soil and groundwater samples for analysis to assess the soil and groundwater conditions beneath the tanks.

During the borehole drilling and soil sampling works, we would need you to suspend the operation of and move the aboveground storage tanks aside so that we can mobilize our drilling machine to the proposed sampling location. We understand that the aboveground storage tanks are crucial to your normal operation, thus, your boilers may not be able to function or you may need to find alternative fuels for normal functioning.

We would be much appreciated if you could advise your concern on our works.
