
**PFC Paper No. 6/2012 (Rev. A)  
Construction and Demolition Material Management Plan (C&DMMP) for  
the Development of Lok Ma Chau Loop**

I refer to your submission of the proposed C&DMMP for the development of Lok Ma Chau Loop project.

2. Subsequent to the circulation of the C&DMMP via PFC Paper No. 6/2012 on 19 November 2012, comments were received from PFC Members. Your response to comments and the revised pages of the C&DMMP were circulated to PFC Members via PFC Paper No. 6/2012 (Rev. A) on 4 December 2012. PFC Members have no further comment and endorsed the PFC Paper No. 6/2012 (Rev. A).

3. I am pleased to advise you that, in accordance with the Project Administration Handbook Chapter 4 Section 4.1.3, the C&DMMP for the development of Lok Ma Chau Loop project attached in PFC Paper No. 6/2012 and the revised pages attached in PFC Paper No. 6/2012 (Rev. A) have been endorsed in principle by the PFC on the conditions that the project proponent shall:

- (a) liaise with concurrent projects, such as Regulation of Shenzhen River Phase 4 and Liantang/Heung Yuen Wai Boundary Control Point, on the feasibility to import public fill from these projects and/or deliver surplus public fill to these projects for beneficial reuse;
- (b) liaise with the Fill Management Division on the arrangement of import of public fill and disposal of surplus inert C&D material to the public fill reception facilities;
- (c) set up effective control procedures to ensure the traceability of disposal and re-use of the C&D materials; and
- (d) report the outcome of items (a) to (c) above to the Secretary of the Public Fill Committee from time to time. If there are significant changes, the outcome will be circulated to Members for agreement.

**Planning and Engineering (P&E) Study on Development of**  
**Lok Ma Chau Loop – Investigation**  
**Construction & Demolition Materials Management Plan (C&DMMP)**

I refer to your above quoted memo and the subsequent emails dated 28 Sep 2012 and 3 Oct 2012 providing responses to our comments.

2. The CEDD Vetting Committee on C&D Materials Management has endorsed the C&DMMP for the captioned project dated September 2012 subject to the following comments:-

- (a) Table 7.1 & 7.2 – Please monitor the implementation programme of works on the flushing service reservoir and Eastern Connection Road construction. Opportunity should be taken to reuse the C&D material generated from the flushing service reservoir if the programmes match.
- (b) Fig. 6.1, Stage 2 works – Your concern on settlement risk associated with reusing excavated swamp deposit as permanent fill in Zone 4 is noted. However, there should be other means to minimize such settlement risk. Besides, please assess in the detailed design stage the technical viability of removing the swamp deposit from Zone 4 without adversely affecting the adjoining land formation. It is noted that the net fill requirement would not be affected.
- (c) Fig. 6.1, Stage 3 works - Please review the surcharging programme for Zone 3 and the filling programme for Zone 4 & 5 in the detailed design stage to explore the possibility of reusing the surcharge materials from Zone 3. Even though the net fill requirement from fill bank remains unchanged, it is considered double handling of public fill with the fill banks should be avoided for budgetary and environmental reasons.

3. Please report to the Vetting Committee your findings/responses to the above comment. Please also note that, in accordance with paragraph 8 of CEDD TC No. 05/2005, you should revise the C&DMMP and submit it to the Vetting Committee for endorsement should there be any changes in the scope of works, design, site conditions or availability of more data/information in the detailed design stage or any other circumstances that have significant implications on the C&D materials management of the project.
