to TD, i.e. to adjust the traffic growth figures of the LMC local network upwards up to the year 2021to reflect the increased volume of local traffic observed in recent surveys by you; but to keep the figures for 2021 and beyond unchanged.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that our comments on the draft TR8C are yet to be addressed. In particular, the need to use of the latest available planning data and other input assumptions for producing traffic forecasts in TR8C. The 2006-based TPEDM have been superseded by the 2009-based TPEDM which were available for use in government studies from June 2011 onwards. In addition, the assumptions in network, economic growth, vehicle fleet size, cross-boundary, port-related land use and airport throughput that were adopted in the course of producing TR5C have now become outdated.
