	Address	No. 21 Tai Kiu Tsuen, Yuen Long, N.T.
	Description	No. 21 Tai Kiu Tsuen was built in 1939 and owned by the Chan clan who originated from Dongguan. In the past, villagers of Tai Kiu Tsuen used well water until the introduction of running water in the late 1950s. Electricity, however, was already available after the Japanese Occupation (1941-1945). The house is now occupied by the Chans and still in good condition.
