We refer to your comments on the selected representative noise assessment points for the captioned EIA Study in our letter dated 28 October 2015 (our ref.: 40033037/445901) via email on 19 Nov 2015. The selected representative noise assessment points have been updated. We are pleased to enclose herewith a figure showing the boundary of assessment area, locations and descriptions of the updated representative noise assessment points (N1 to N3) for your agreement in accordance with Section 2.2.1 (a) & (c) and Section 3.2.1 (a) & (c) in Appendix B of the EIA Study Brief No. ESB-288/2015. Photographs of the updated representative noise sensitive receivers are also enclosed for your information.

According to the land status information as indicated in your comments, there are some building structures near N3. Referring to aerial photograph, no potential building structures are found. Based on our further site visit on 21 November 2015, there was no access road to potential building structures around N3. Therefore, those building structures are believed to be deserted. Nonetheless, N3 is selected as a representative noise assessment point for these building structures under construction and operational noise assessments in this EIA Study to ensure that the Project would not cause any unacceptable adverse noise impacts to N3, in case these building structures are inhabited during the construction and operational phases of the Project.






