- Past and present incident records of the area within the Tentative Works Area.

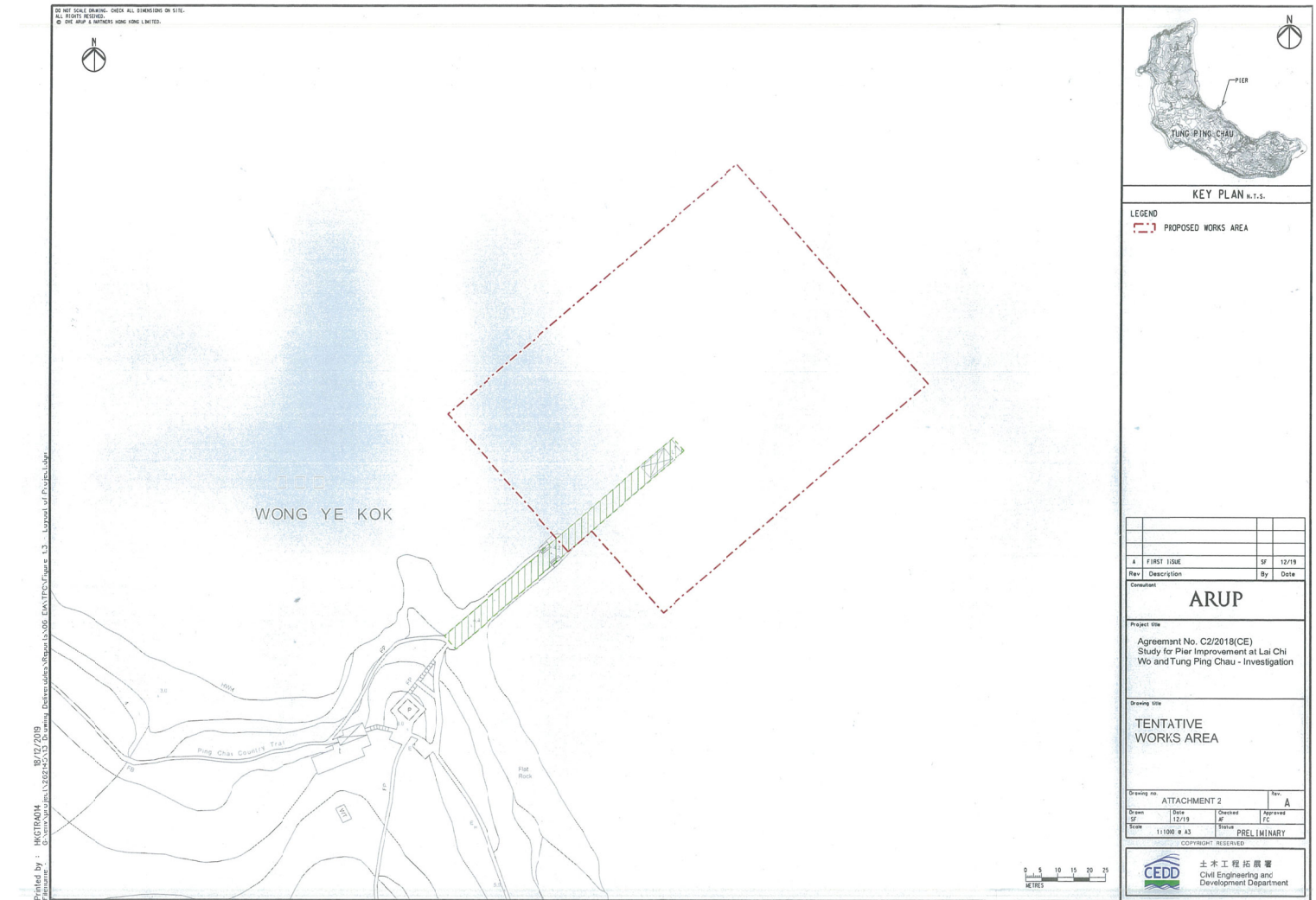

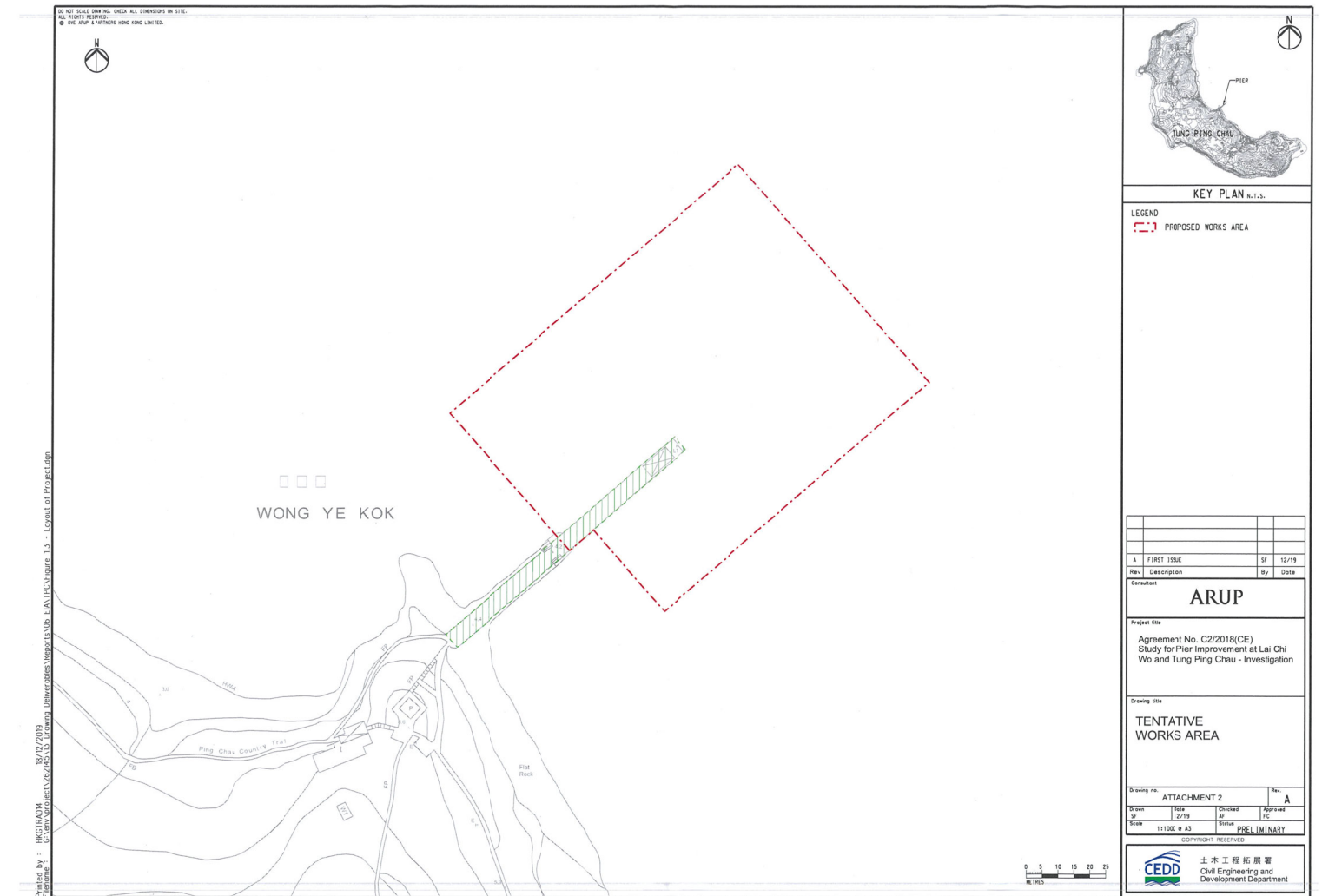
