

"Glass is not waste but resources," suggested **Prof C.S. Poon** of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, one of the pioneers in Hong Kong researching on the potential applications of glass cullet in the construction industry.

"I am proud of participating in glass recycling," said Mr Sammy Yu of the MTR Corporation, an active player in glass bottle recycling in MTRC-managed properties.
