- Educate developers on the economic benefits of historical preservation

Unmitigated Responses

- Resource stock is not yet fully known or appreciated
- Few controls on preservation since many properties are private
- Incentive for rapid development has often resulted in a loss of the resource
- Many areas of high archaeological potential (ie coastlines) have already been reclaimed

Antiquities, Archaeological and Historic Resources

- Continued loss of known and potential heritage resources
- Forfeiture of economic (eg tourism) cultural and educational opportunities
- Diminution of aesthetic quality of the landscape
