Give a detailed description of the collection operation, and

- (a) the detailed specifications of the vehicles/vessels employed to collect wastes (attach drawings and photos);
- (b) the location and layout of the maintenance depot (attach location map);
- (c) types of establishments and their geographical locations from which the wastes are to be collected;
- (d) the materials, number and size of containers or storage receptacles employed for carrying the wastes to be collected and transported;
- (e) waste handling procedures including the loading/unloading of wastes on and off the vehicles or vessels;
- (f) measures for dealing with wastes in the event of mechanical failure or minor accident of the vehicle/vessel without resulting in spillage of chemical waste to the environment [Back-Up Measures] ;
- (g) provisions made for pollution control and monitoring of possible emissions including air and noxious pollutants, dust, noise and liquid spillage during transportation [Emergency Response Plan] ;
- (h) safety equipment and Transport Emergency Cards to be provided;
- (i) manning levels, and qualifications and experience of operational personnel; and
- (j) arrangements for keeping records.

Purpose of Collection

1. The personal data provided by means of this form will be used by Environmental Protection Department for one or more of the following purposes:
 - a. activities relating to the processing of your submission in this form;
 - b. administration and enforcement of relevant environmental legislation;

 - d. statistical and any other legitimate purposes; and
 - e. to facilitate communications between Government and yourself.

2. It is obligatory for you to supply the personal data as required by this form. If you do not provide sufficient information, your application is incomplete.

Classes of Transferees

 - a. other government bureaus and departments, and any other organisations for the purposes mentioned in paragraph 1 above, and
 - b. other persons as permitted by the relevant legislation.

4. You have a right of access and correction with respect to personal data as provided for in section 18 and 22 and principle 6 of Schedule 1 of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance. Your right of access includes the right to obtain a copy of your personal data provided by this form.

How to Apply for a Chemical Waste Collection Licence

The completed application form can be handed in at any office of Environmental Protection Department, or mailed to our Territorial Control Office (Address: 28/F, Southorn Centre, 130 Hennessy Road, Environmental Protection Department, Wanchai, Hong Kong). You must submit, together with the application form, copies of supplementary information and documents, e.g. business registration certificate, certificate of incorporation, licences of vehicles or vessels and their insurance policies, etc. You must also submit an operational plan listing out detailed arrangements for the collection and transportation of waste.

On receipt of the application, EPD will issue to you a demand note for the application fee. When we receive your payment receipt, we will start to process your application and seek further information or clarification from you. The time it takes to issue a licence will depend on how quickly you can supply complete information and pass the vehicle/vessel examination. The application fee will not be refunded. If you intend to export the chemical waste you have collected, or import chemical waste into Hong Kong, you must obtain a waste export or import permit as appropriate. Please contact our enquiry hotline on waste import and export control at 27555462 for details.
