IT 21002)” (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer), addressed to the Chairman, Tender Opening Committee, Government Logistics Department and deposited in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box situated on the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before 12:00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on 25 October 2021. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice (“Specified Tender Box”) before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted. In the event that tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above or a black rainstorm warning signal is in effect or “extreme conditions after super typhoons” announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on 25 October 2021, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the tropical cyclone signal No.8 is lowered or the black rainstorm signal or “extreme conditions after super typhoons” announced by the Government has ceased to be in effect.
