6B. Technical Proposal

6.6 A Tenderer shall include with its Technical Proposal, proposals in accordance with the requirements as set out in Part 3A Services Specifications. A Tenderer shall also include in its Technical Proposal with Tenderer's and Project Team members' experience including but not limited to the following:

- (a) Cumulative experience of Project Team members in the [ten (10)] years prior to the Original Tender Closing Time in accordance with Paragraph 7.2 of Terms of Tender below;
- (b) Tenderer's cumulative experience in developing systems for providing real-time electronic data collection and management service in the [ten (10)] years prior to the Original Tender Closing Time;
- (c) Number of completed real-time electronic data collection and management service projects by the Tenderer as of the Original Tender Closing Time, in which the value of each project is over one million Hong Kong dollars;
- (d) Tenderer's cumulative experience in collection, transportation and disposal of clinical or chemical waste generated in Hong Kong.

Such Technical Proposal shall be submitted in **Envelope B**. Tenderer shall provide supporting documents / documentary proof with respect to the claimed experience, including but not limited to Curriculum vitae of each member of the Project Team, at the same time when it submits its Tender. A Tenderer's claimed experience that is not supported by supporting documents / documentary proof shall not be considered valid.

6.8 The information submitted in the Technical Proposal will form part of the Tender to be evaluated by the Government.

6.9 Without prejudice to any other provision of these Terms of Tender, if any part of the Technical Proposal is accepted by the Government, they will be legally binding on the successful Tenderer and form part of the Contract.

7. Essential Requirements and other Requirements
