Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notices ("Specified Tender Box") before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted. In the event of tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above or a black rainstorm warning signal is in effect at any time between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on 29 August 2019, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12:00 noon on the first working day after the tropical cyclone warning signal No.8 is lowered or the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect.
