- Submission of tenders : Completed Tender Documents and all accompanying documents must be completed, signed in EIGHT identical copies and enclosed in a sealed plain envelope marked of the following: “Tender Reference No. WR19048 and Contract No. EP/SP/119/19 - Pilot Scheme on Collection and Recycling Services of Plastic Recyclable Materials – Sha Tin District” and/or “Tender Reference No. WR19048 and Contract No. EP/SP/118/19 - Pilot Scheme on Collection and Recycling Services of Plastic Recyclable Materials – Kwun Tong District” (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer), addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board and deposited in the Government Secretariat Tender Box situated at Lobby of the Public Entrance on the Ground Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong before 12:00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on 8 November 2019. Tenders must be deposited in the tender box as specified in this tender notice (“Specified Tender Box”) before the tender closing time. Late tenders and tenders not deposited in the Specified Tender Box will not be accepted. If tropical cyclone signal No. 8 or above is hoisted, or a black rainstorm warning signal or “extreme conditions after super typhoons” announced by the Government is/are in force at any time between 9:00 am and 12:00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on the tender closing date, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12:00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on the first working day after the tropical cyclone signal No. 8 is lowered, or the black rainstorm warning signal or the “extreme conditions after super typhoons” announced by the Government has/have ceased to be in force. In case of blockage of the public access to the location of the Specified Tender Box at any time between 9:00 am and 12:00 noon (Hong Kong Time) on the tender closing date, the Government will announce extension of the tender closing time until further notice. Following removal of the blockage, the Government will announce the extended tender closing time as soon as practicable. The above announcements will be made via press releases on the website of Information Services Department (<http://www.info.gov.hk/gia/general/today.htm>).

- Important Notes : Tenderer must submit a duly signed Offer to be Bound, an Outline Operation Plan of the Technical Proposal, an information of tenderer and a duly signed undertaking. Tenderer must submit the above documents in its Technical Proposal on or before the Tender Closing Date. Tenderer fails to submit any of the above documents will render its tender invalid and will not be considered further.
- Remarks : 1. Open tendering is adopted. The qualifications/conditions for participation and other tender requirements are stipulated in the Terms of Tender in the tender documents.
2. This tender is covered by the Agreement on Government Procurement of the World Trade Organization and will not involve electronic auction. This notice also serves as a summary notice required under the Agreement on Government Procurement of the World Trade Organization.
3. The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region does not bind itself to accept any tender irrespective of whether the tender is the lowest bid or, as the assessment of the tenders is based on a marking scheme, the tender has the highest combined score of Price Offer and Technical Proposal.
4. The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region reserves the right to negotiate with any tenderer about the terms of the offer.
