# Advice to Truck Drivers Importing or Exporting Ozone Depleting Substances



### **Controlled Items**

# Refrigerants and other Ozone Depleting Substances (ODSs)

The Ozone Layer Protection Ordinance controls the import and export of ODSs. The 8 categories of ODSs subject to control are CFCs, halons, 1,1,1-Trichloroethane, carbon tetrachloride, methyl bromide, HBFCs, HCFCs and BCM.

#### Common ODSs include:

CFC12 (Refrigerant 12) **HALONS** (Fire Extinguishers) HCFC 22 (Refrigerant 22) HCFC 22/CFC 115 (Refrigerant 502) HCFC 141b (Cleaning solvent) **HCFC 225** (Cleaning solvent) 1.1.1-Trichloroethane (Cleaning solvent) Methyl Bromide (Pesticide)

## **Truck Drivers' Duties**

Drivers importing or exporting ODSs

- (a) MUST be able to produce a valid import or export licence;
- (b) MUST check the cargoes before making the manifest; and
- (c) MUST declare the full names of any ODSs on the manifest.
