- (1) The master, the owner (including owner, bareboat charterer, manager and operator of the vessel) or the agent of a vessel may apply to the Environmental Protection Department (the EPD) for an exemption from the application of section 4(1) of the Air Pollution Control (Ocean Going Vessels) (Fuel at Berth) Regulation (the Regulation) (Cap 311AA) if compliance with the section 4(1) of the Regulation may pose a risk to the safety of the vessel.
- (2) The application must be made at least 14 days before the date on which the vessel is intended to enter the waters of Hong Kong for the exempted call in relation to the exemption under section 6(1)(b) of the Regulation.
- (3) The EPD may require the applicant to provide any further information or documents that it considers necessary for determining the application.
- (4) Exemption, if granted, under section 6(1)(b) of the Regulation is valid for 1 exempted call only.
