

Trial Scheme on “Reserved Parking Spaces for EVs” in Government Car Parks Implemented by the Transport Department

To facilitate electric vehicle (EV) users to charge their EVs, the Transport Department is implementing a trial scheme with effect from 1 August 2020 to designate some parking spaces equipped with EV chargers in the government car parks under its management for exclusive use by EVs (hereafter referred as “reserved parking spaces for EVs”).

The concerned car parks and the number of “reserved parking spaces for EVs” under the trial scheme are tabulated below:

| Car Park | Number of Parking Spaces Reserved for EVs |
|---------------|---|
| Rumsey Street | 14 |
| Star Ferry | 16 |
| City Hall | 12 |
| Tin Hau | 15 |

Conspicuous signs and notices (see photo) are displayed at the “reserved parking spaces for EVs” for easy identification.

Any non-EVs occupying the “reserved parking space for EVs” would be impounded and these non-EVs will be released upon settlement of the impounding charge of \$320.

The Transport Department is reviewing the effectiveness of the trial scheme.
