

## INSTALLATION MANUAL OF CONVERSION SOFTWARE TNMSDX

### System Requirements

Any PC running with operating system of Windows 95/98/NT/2000 with 64 MB or above physical RAM. Internet connection to download the installation file.

### Installation

*Step 1* Download the archived installation file **tnmsdx.zip** from the EPD web site ([http://www.epd.gov.hk/epd/english/environmentinhk/noise/guide\\_ref/files/tnmsdx.zip](http://www.epd.gov.hk/epd/english/environmentinhk/noise/guide_ref/files/tnmsdx.zip)).

*Step 2* Unzip the file **tnmsdx.zip** with WinZip (can be downloaded at [www.winzip.com](http://www.winzip.com)). Three files will be self-extracted: **setup.exe**, **setup.lst** and **TNMSDX.cab**.

*Step 3* Quit other running applications. Run **setup.exe** from the Start Menu or by double clicking the icon of the file.




Figure 1. Choose “Ignore” when messages like this is prompted when running **setup.exe**.

*Step 4* Some files will be copied to the system. If message like “*The destination file is write protected*” is prompted as shown in Figure 1, choose “**Ignore**” to continue the installation process.

*Step 5* A setup screen is displayed as shown in Figure 2. Click “**OK**” to continue.




Figure 3. Selecting of installation directory.

Step 6 The setup program will ask the user to select a directory path for installation as shown in Figure 3. After a desired directory has been selected, click the icon button to continue.




Figure 4. Selecting of Program Group.

Step 7 The user is asked to enter a name of a Program Group for the application in the Start Menu as shown in Figure 4. The default Program Group is "TNMSDX". Click "Continue" after selecting the Program Group.




Figure 5. Version conflict of files to be installed.

*Step 8* The setup program will then install all the necessary files to the computer. Messages of “**Version Conflict**” would be prompted during installation as shown in Figure 5 if a file to be copied to the system is older than that already exist in the system. Click “**Yes**” to keep the current version of the file in the system or click “**No**” to install the version provided by the installation program.

*Step 9* A screen as shown in Figure 6 will be displayed after installation is completed. Click “**OK**” to finish the setup. Restart the computer after installation.
