# 1.0

## Message from the Convenor

Battery recycling is a fairly new concept in Hong Kong. People are often not aware that many appliances in their homes and offices use rechargeable batteries. They also do not realise these batteries contain recyclable materials and may otherwise be hazardous if they are dumped in landfills. The Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme aims to raise people's awareness and change their habits. In this respect, we have had a very successful first year.

Between our launch in April 2005 and March 2006 we achieved a 5% recovery rate, about double what other places typically achieve. An extensive collection network is in place and continuing to expand. Moreover, the battery and electronic equipment industry is helping to organise and finance the Programme under a voluntary producer responsibility scheme. This not only ensures batteries are dealt with in a more environmentally friendly way, it also demonstrates to other industries that it is viable for them to take responsibility for the environmental impacts of their products.

Having put a system in place, we need to work a little harder to raise people's awareness. A survey conducted in January 2006 showed that only about half of the people in Hong Kong are aware of the Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme. Our two-year goal is to recycle 10% of rechargeable batteries by March 2007. We will seek to step up our publicity efforts so more people can participate in this worthy Programme.

# 2.0

## About the Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme

### 2.1 Background

Rechargeable batteries contain valuable materials that can be reused as stainless steel and magnetic alloy. Until recently, these batteries ended up in landfills. Then in April 2002 the pilot Mobile Phone Battery Recycling Programme was launched. This marked two firsts for Hong Kong: the first battery recycling programme, and the first voluntary producer responsibility scheme (PRS). Mobile phone and battery manufacturers organised and funded it, and the Environmental Protection Department (EPD) and mobile phone network service providers provided support.

The pilot Programme demonstrated that the recovery of rechargeable batteries is feasible in Hong Kong. On 9 April 2005 the Rechargeable

Battery Recycling Programme was launched and extended collection to all kinds of portable rechargeable batteries. This is also a voluntary PRS organised and funded by industry. The EPD and two green groups – Friends of the Earth and Green Power – provide technical, administrative and promotional support.

## 2.2 Participating Companies

The Programme has 34 organising companies, who are manufacturers and importers of rechargeable batteries and electronic equipment (see Annex 1 for a list of companies). They also provide funding for the Programme. Tier One companies pay \$25,000 per year and Tier Two companies pay \$5,000 per year. They contributed HK\$510,000 in total in the Programme's first year.

Under this producer responsibility scheme, the onus for recovering rechargeable batteries is shared among producers, importers, retailers and consumers.

## 2.3 Working Group

The Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme is administered by a tri-partite Working Group with membership from industry, the EPD and green groups. In 2005-06, the Working Group comprised 19 members (see Annex II for a list of members). Dr Lawrence Wong of the Environmental Protection Department was Convenor and Dr C.S. Man of Green Power was Treasurer. A working group meeting was held on 24 August 2005 and an Annual General Meeting was held on 8 March 2006.

## 2.4 How the Programme Works

The Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme accepts lithium ion, nickel metal hydride and nickel cadmium batteries at collection points across Hong Kong. This is a free service and the batteries are sent to recycling facilities overseas.

Retailers, mass transit operators, property management companies and schools have been invited to provide collection points so as to enhance the effectiveness of the Programme. There are two kinds of collection points. Primary collection points are located in railway stations, chain stores and other shops accessible to the general public. These have been set up by the 34 organising companies, as well as series of supporting companies who are mainly retailers and railway operators (see Annex III for a list of

supporting companies). The companies collect the batteries internally from their collection points and bring them to a central storage point(s) where they are picked up by the Programme's appointed collector.

Secondary collection points are set up in participating housing estates, commercial/industrial buildings and schools (see list in Annex IV). The recovered batteries are delivered to nearby primary collection points, where they are picked up by the collector.


## Review of Operations

### 3.1 Collection

#### Quantities

The Government has set a target to recover and recycle 10% of Hong Kong's rechargeable battery waste by March 2007. From 9 April 2005 to 31 March 2006, 13 tonnes of rechargeable batteries were collected, or 320,000 individual batteries, representing 5% of the total. About 40% of the batteries collected came from the industrial and commercial sector. The recovery result compares well with similar voluntary programmes in other countries in the first year, which typically collect 2-3% of their rechargeable battery waste.

#### Collection Points

The number of collection points expanded by more than 40% during the year. When the Programme was launched on 9 April 2005 we had 1,071 collection points. By 31 March 2006 there were 1,514 collection points, covering all districts of Hong Kong.

### *Industrial and Commercial Battery Waste*

Some companies generate large quantities of battery waste in their daily activities – a combined total of about 50 tonnes per year. Until recently, this waste has been handled under chemical waste regulations, in which a licensed collector brought the waste to landfills for safe disposal.

At the recommendation of the EPD, the Working Group agreed to expand the Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme to accept industrial/commercial battery waste. Since June 2005 the EPD has been approaching waste producers to recycle their batteries under this Programme rather than sending them to landfills. The waste producers pay a collection and recycling fee each time their batteries are picked up. In early 2006, the Mass Transit Railway Corporation became the first company to join the Programme.

Industrial and commercial companies that generate large quantities of battery waste pay a recycling and collection fee. Otherwise the service is free for members of the public.

#### *Collector*

Dunwell Environmental Management Company Limited is the contracted collector for the Programme. In addition to picking up batteries from central storage points, the collector sorts, weighs and places masking tape over the terminals of each battery.

The collector collects on a monthly or bi-monthly basis depending on the location and also makes special collections on request.

### **3.2 Recycling**

Rechargeable batteries contain valuable metals, such as cobalt, nickel and cadmium, that can be recovered and sold for re-use in stainless steel, magnetic alloy and cadmium batteries. The first batch of 13 tonnes of rechargeable batteries was sent to a recycling facility in South Korea in April 2006.

### 3.3 Publicity

An intensive publicity campaign was conducted under the Programme's auspices from September 2005-March 2006. Among the highlights we:

- Produced an Announcement in the Public Interest on the Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme for radio and television broadcast
- Displayed advertisements on the exterior of 25 buses and 5 trams, and in television broadcasts in New World First Bus vehicles
- Advertised in all MTR stations and some KCRC stations
- Produced educational kits for schools
- Included promotional messages in electricity, water and gas bills
- Displayed posters on the Programme in government offices and post offices
- Conducted more than 50 outreach visits to schools and housing estates
- Organised poster and battery collection box design competitions in schools and housing estates



### 3.4 Survey

The City University was engaged to conduct a telephone survey in January 2006 to assess awareness and participation in the Programme. The views of more than 1,000 people have been collected. Among the findings:


- 49% of respondents were aware of the Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme.
- Among those aware of the programme, 36% knew where to locate collection points. More needs to be done here to publicise these facilities.


- 73% intended to recycle their rechargeable batteries, of which 43% said they would probably recycle and 30% said they would definitely do so. A strong publicity drive helped and we will continue to promote the Programme in the community.

## 4.0

### Financial Review

The Programme finished the year with a surplus. This is because we budgeted for a 10% collection rate in the first year and achieved 5%.

The surplus as at March 2006 was HK\$147,809.9, which will be dedicated to publicity efforts.

## 5.0

### Looking Ahead

The first year of the Rechargeable Battery Recycling Programme has laid down foundations for collection and awareness. The Working Group is confident that as we build on these foundations, we can significantly expand

battery recycling and divert useful materials away from Hong Kong's landfills.


Two priorities will dominate the second year of the Programme, namely education and publicity, and recruitment of new members.

**Education and Publicity**  
We need to encourage more people to use and recycle rechargeable batteries, and be aware of what products use these batteries. In 2006-07 we will advertise on buses and trams, in train stations, government facilities, shopping malls and newspapers, and on television and radio. We will also launch the education kit loan service, organise recovery competitions and make at least 50 outreach visits to housing estates and schools.

**Recruitment**  
The collection network needs to be further expanded to make it easier

for people to recycle, and to ensure all companies that generate rechargeable batteries are participating. We will look to open more primary and secondary collection points. We will also recruit new members. Some companies that generate sizeable quantities of rechargeable battery waste have not joined our Programme yet their batteries end up in our bins. These "free-riders" accounted for 10% of the total waste rechargeable batteries collected in 2005-06. The Working Group and the EPD will communicate with their management to encourage them to join.

Additional funding will be needed to finance an expanded collection network and publicity drive. In 2006-07 we are seeking \$650,000, much of which we hope will come from new members.

# 6.0

召集人的序言

在香港，回收充電池是一個頗為嶄新的概念。人們往往並無留意他們家中和辦公室的電子用品有很多都使用充電池，也不知道這些電池含有可再造物料，如果棄置在堆置區可能會變成有害物質。我們推行「充電池回收計劃」的目的，是希望提高市民在這方面的意識和改變他們的習慣。計劃推行的首年成績已相當不俗，令人鼓舞。

計劃自二零零五年四月推出以來至二零零六年三月底，充電池的回收率已達到5%，較其他地區一般的回收率高出約一倍之多。現行的回收網絡已覆蓋廣泛地區，但我們仍會不斷擴大範圍。電池和電子產品業界透過生產者責任計劃籌辦和提供所需經費，不但確保能以較環保的方式處理充電池，更可以向其他行業證明，生產者承擔產品對環境影響的責任是可實行的。

建立了適當的機制以後，下一步便是致力提高公眾意識。在二零零六年一月進行的一項調查顯示，僅有約半數香港市民知道有「充電池回收計劃」。我們所訂的兩年目標是在二零零七年三月底或之前回收率達到10%。因此，我們會加強宣傳，呼籲更多市民積極參與這項饒有意義的計劃。

### 7.1 背景

充電池含有具回收價值的物料，可以循環再用製成不銹鋼和磁性合金等產品。一直以來，這類電池都是棄置在堆填區，直至在二零零二年四月推出「流動電話電池回收試驗計劃」情況才有所改變。這項試驗計劃標誌著香港的兩個第一：即首個電池回收計劃和首個自願性生產者責任計劃。試驗計劃由流動電話和電池製造商籌辦和提供所需費用，並由環境保護署和流動電話網絡服務供應商協力推行。

試驗計劃的結果顯示，在香港回收充電池是可行的。在二零零五年四月九日展開的「充電池回收計劃」

## 7.4 計劃如何運作

「充電池回收計劃」在香港多處地點設置回收點，收集鋰離子（Li-ion）、鎳氫（NiMH）和鎳鎘（NiCd）電池。這項服務費用全免，所收集的電池會運往海外設施循環再造。

為使計劃更具成效，我們邀請零售商、鐵路營辦商、物業管理公司和學校提供回收點。計劃設有主要和輔助回收點。主要回收點設於市民大眾容易接觸到的鐵路車站、連鎖店和其他零售店。它們由多間支援公司（大部份是零售商和鐵路營辦商）和34間籌辦公司設置（支援公司的名單見附件三）。這些公司將

## 7.2 參與公司

參與籌辦的公司共有34間充電池和電子產品的生產商和進口商（公司名單見附件一）。這些公司為計劃提供所需經費。產生較多廢充電池的公司每年支付25,000元，較少的公司每年5,000元。計劃首年所籌集的資金共港幣51萬元。

根據這項生產者責任計劃，回收充電池的責任由生產商、進口商、零售商和消費者共同承擔。

## 7.3 工作小組

「充電池回收計劃」由業界、環境保護署和環保團體組成的三方夥伴工作小組負責管理。在二零零五至零六年度，工作小組共有19名成員（成員名單見附件二）。環境保護署黃棟剛博士為工作小組召集人，而綠色力量的文志森博士則擔任司庫。此計劃分別於二零零五年八月二十四日舉行工作小組會議，及於二零零六年三月八日召開周年大會。


# 8.0

## 檢討運作

### 8.1 收集

**數量：**政府的目標，是在二零零七年三月底前回收本港10%廢棄充電池循環再造。在二零零五年四月九日至二零零六年三月三十一日，我們共回收了13公噸充電池（相等於320,000枚），佔廢棄充電池總數5%。回收的電池約40%來自工商業。其他國家也有推行類似的自願性計劃，但首年的回收率一般只有2%至3%，相比之下，香港的成績已相當不俗。

**回收點：**年內，回收點的數目增加了超過40%。我們最初在二零零五年四月九日推出計劃之時，共設置了1,071個回收點。到了二零零六年三月三十一日，回收點的數目已增至1,514個，遍布全港各區。

# 循環再造

**工商業電池廢物：**有些公司在日常的業務中會產生大量電池廢物：全港總數約為一年50公噸。這些廢物一直受化學廢物規例管制，由持牌收集商運到堆填區以安全的方法處置。

工作小組接納了環境保護署的建議，同意擴大「充電池回收計劃」的範圍，接收工商業電池廢物。自二零零五年六月起，環境保護署一直聯絡各主要廢物生產者，勸諭他們不要再將廢充電池運往堆填區棄置，應該參與回收計劃以將廢電池循環再造。廢物生產者每次須支付收集及循環再造費用。地下鐵路公司是首間參與計劃的機構。

產生大量電池廢物的工商業機構須支付收集及循環再造費用，而市民則可免費使用這項服務。

**收集商：**正昌環境管理有限公司是計劃的指定持牌收集商。除了到各參與及支援公司的中央點收集電池外，收集商還須將電池分類和量重，以及在每枚電池的金屬端子上貼上遮蔽保護膠紙（皺紋膠紙）。

收集商會每隔一個或兩個月收集廢電池一次，視乎數量而定，亦會按要求作特別的收集安排。

#### 8.2 循環再造

充電池含有具價值的物料例如鈷、鎳和鎘等，可回收及出售作不銹鋼、磁合金和鎘電池的材料。首批重13公噸的充電池已於二零零六年四月運往南韓循環再造。

### 8.3 宣傳推廣

在二零零五年九月至二零零六年三月，環境保護署為計劃大力進行宣傳活動。重點宣傳包括：

- 拍攝一套有關「充電池回收計劃」的政府宣傳聲帶和短片，供電台和電視台播放。
- 在25輛巴士和5輛電車的車身展示廣告，並在新巴巴士上播放廣告宣傳短片。
- 在各地鐵站和部分九鐵車站刊登廣告。
- 製作供學校使用的教材套。
- 在電費、水費及煤氣費帳單內加入宣傳信息。
- 在政府設施和郵政局張貼計劃的海報。
- 到學校及屋苑進行超過50次外展探訪活動。
- 在學校和屋苑舉辦海報及電池回收箱設計比賽。



### 8.4 就公眾意識和參與進行的調查

我們在二零零六年一月聘請城市大學進行電話調查，以評估市民對計劃的認識和參與程度。超過1,000名市民接受了電話訪問。調查結果發現：

- 知道「充電池回收計劃」的受訪者佔49%。
- 在知道該計劃的市民當中，只有36%知道哪裡可以找到回收點。我們有必要向市民加強宣傳回收點位置。





# 9.0

## 財務檢討

「充電池回收計劃」在本年度有盈餘，原因是我們用10%回收率作首年預算，而全年回收了5%。

截至二零零六年三月為止，計劃有港幣147,809.9元盈餘，這筆款項會用於來年的宣傳工作上。

# 10.

## 展望未來

「充電池回收計劃」推行的首年，已在回收工作及提高公眾意識方面奠下根基。工作小組有信心能在這個基礎上，大幅擴展電池回收和減少把有用的物料送到本港堆填區棄置。

計劃進入第二年後，我們的工作主要會集中於兩個優先項目，即宣傳教育和吸納新成員。

**宣傳教育：**我們必須鼓勵更多市民使用及回收充電池，以及認識哪些產品可以使用充電池。在二零零六至零七年度，我們會在電車站、鐵路車站和報章進行宣傳，並會拍攝新的廣告短片及在電視台和電台播放政府宣傳短片和聲帶。我們亦會推出教材套借用服務、舉辦回收比賽，以及到屋苑和學校進行至少50次外訪。

**招募工作：**我們必須進一步擴大回收點網絡，讓市民更容易參與回收活動。此外，亦須確保所有產生充電池的公司都參與其中。我們會嘗試增加主要及輔助回收點的數目，

以及吸納新成員。

雖然一些充電池和電子產品的生產商和進口商仍未參與計劃，不過，他們的消費者所產生的廢充電池最終都被投放到回收箱內。來自這些「坐享其成」者的廢充電池佔二零零五至零六年度回收總數的10%。工作小組和環境保護署會與這些公司的管理層聯絡，設法鼓勵他們參與。

由於要擴大回收網絡和進行宣傳，我們需要額外的資金。二零零六至零七年度所需的經費為港幣65萬元，我們寄望新成員能增加計劃的收入。
