Qualified students will be endorsed, with the Top 10 given Full Scholarships to participate in Overseas Exchanges. In 2007, we have sponsored 40 students to youth exchange in 21 cities in 13 countries in 4 continents.

You are cordially invited to encourage Forms 4 to 7 students (particularly those who are Student Environmental Protection Ambassadors (SEPA), members of The Hong Kong Award for Young People (AYP) or Ming Pao School Reporters to participate in the Competition. It includes an essay of not more than 1000 English words on Green Life Style and an interview. It will enhance their awareness on environmental issues, broaden their horizons, polish their English and research skills. AYP members' participation in a Lions overseas exchange can also be used to fulfill the Gold Level Residential Project Section requirement. SEPA participating in the competition can obtain endorsement from this Committee for the participation in the Outstanding SEPA Scheme Competition.
