I have following comments concerning your clean harbour proposal :

a. I am really disappointed by the idea of constructing deep water pipes under the harbour for transporting

sewage. I hope we should bear in mind that building pipes deep under the ground and harbour is a technical difficult and expensive task and hong kong is surely not a place for technical unmatre project. Recall what we learnt when we built deep water pipes under the ground of Kowloon - we came across water leakage problem , complex rock constituent, withdrawal of construction companies and , more importantly, cost greatly exceed budget. My opinion is that we should focus on simple solution by constructing 3 sewage treatment plant on Lantau, hong kong island and kowloon. On one hand, we may create more job opportunity and also it is technically feasible and more easy to manage.
